- c) Other fees, such as extra meals and performance sailing shirts, will be identified for purchase within the Registration Form.
- d) Firecracker Regatta Registrants shall complete the registration form and submit to www.kycsail.us or to Regatta Registration before or on July 5.

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000 per event or the equivalent.
