We have a new electric pressure washer. For large jobs please use the gas powered one. The new one is easier and quieter but not as powerful. If you use it, please put it back where and how you found it.

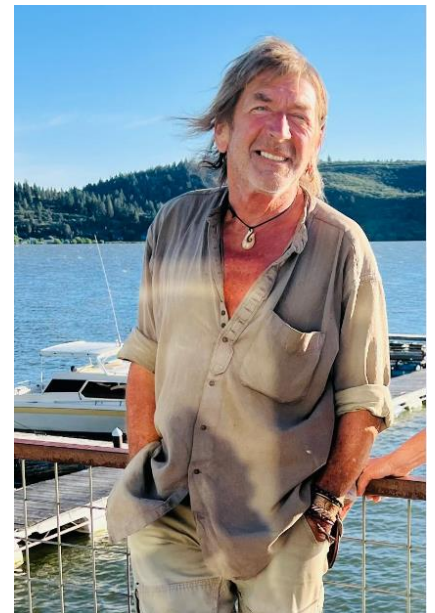
