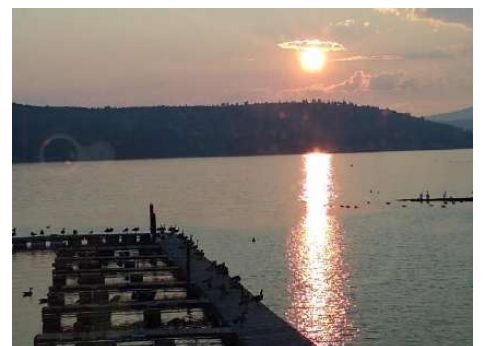

Thanks also to Renea Wood for acquiring a cigarette butler for the deck. It was donated by Blue Zones.

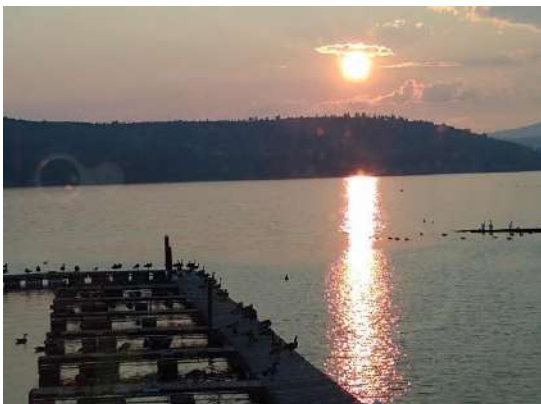
We will be scheduling work parties in the near future to get started on the dock resurfacing and cleaning up around the club grounds.

The 2021 handbooks are available for pickup at the bar.

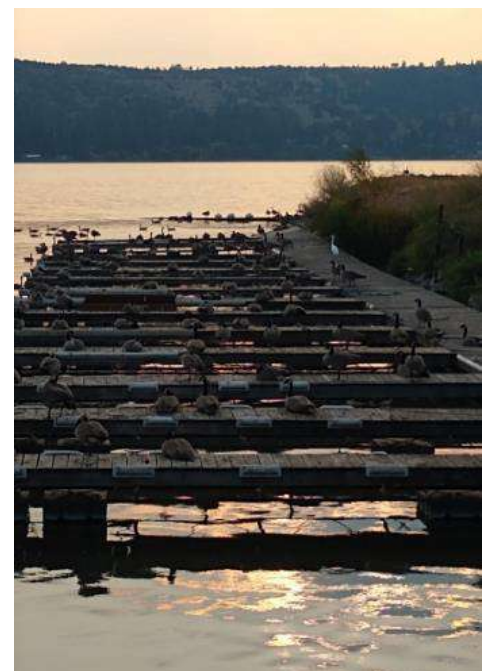
