In case you missed it the first time...

The following is from the KYC Handbook.

Moorage is due annually to all members who have boats at KYC. Moorage will be invoiced to those members January 1 of each year, and shall be PAID IN FULL, no later than April 1 of that same year. Late moorage payments may result in a member's prior year's moorage being reassigned. New Members joining after January of each year, in need of moorage, shall be prorated from their new membership date, through December of that year.

\$120 moorage @ \$10 mo. \$160 moorage @ \$13 mo

Moorage and Storage Fees per Year Schedule.

Dry Moorage \$120 yearly

Wet Moorage

North Harbor \$160 yearly
Center Harbor \$120 ""
South (cat) Harbor \$120 ""

Storage available for boat trailers left on KYC Grounds is located at a small secured lot, to the far North of the KYC property. After launching, all trailers shall be taken to the Boat Trailer Storage Area or removed from KYC. All trailers remaining on KYC Grounds shall be maintained in a serviceable condition. (Functional coupler, tongue jack and inflated tires.) Locks are discouraged, as The Rear Commodore, may from time to time, need to move a particular boat or trailer. Only trailers of moored boats at KYC shall be eligible for storage.

Boats left in the water after November 1 will be fined \$25 plus \$5 per day thereafter. (Adopted November 2008) A maximum of \$500 may be charged for storage of unused boats. (Adopted May 2006; revised January 2009)
