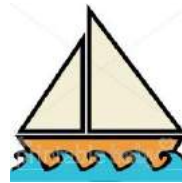

Anyone needing moorage assignments, please contact Mick Mulvey at 541-892-2051. Slip assignments have been designated for all those needing wet moorage. Dry moorage is still a bit up in the air, until such time we get those boats in the water needing slips. We have more members dry sailing this season, so let's get those boats in the water ASAP, and clear the dry moorage area.







In addition, all member and guest parking is located in the south parking area or on the street. There is no parking north of the Clubhouse entrance on race events or on Wednesday night racing. Please advise your guests and crews.

Boat trailer parking is in the boat trailer parking area to the far north of the KYC grounds accessed by a gate. There is NO BOAT TRAILER PARKING in the dry moorage lot.

The trailer spaces located directly in from the gate are reserved for larger boat trailers. In order to facilitate all trailers needing space, trailers need to be stacked, racked, and packed just right. Most are familiar with the process, so please advise those new members needing assistance.
